

Organic matter that can be put in your compost bin,

alternating and in thin layers



"Green" matter - 1/3 of the pile:

- >fruit and vegetable peelings
- >table scraps
- >grass clippings
- >indoor and outdoor plants
- > food past its date
- >garden waste

"Brown" matter - 2/3 of the pile:

- > dead leaves
- >old hay or straw
- >coffee grounds and filters, tea bags, herbal tea
- > napkins, paper towels
- >wood shavings (maximum 5%)
- >shredded cardboard box (ex. pizza box, egg carton)
- >paper food bags

Other matter that can be put in the composter:

- > farm animal manure (mulch)
- >human hair
- >animal hair
- >some dirt or old compost

Do not put :

- rhubarb leaves, cedar clippings
- > left-over meat, fish, bones, dead animals
- > dairy products, oils, fats
- > cat litter, dog or human excrement
- > diapers, sanitary napkins, medicine
- pieces of painted, varnished or treated wood
- > old batteries
- > vacuum cleaner dust
- > papers or newspapers with colored inks that may contain metals or waxed cardboard
- > plastic (containers, bags, wrap, labels...)
- any chemicals, used oil
- > barbeque briquettes
- > rocks, oyster shells
- > metal, aluminum foil
- ceramic
- > logs, branches bigger than 1 cm $(\frac{1}{2}$ ") in diameter, cigarette filters
