What is the role of septic tank owners?

Septic tank owners must be aware of the regulations, comply with them and carry out the steps preceding emptying. Finally, owners must ensure that the contractor has safe access to the property.

What are the responsibilities of municipalities in the management of septic tank sludge?

Since August 12, 1981, municipalities have been responsible for enforcing the Regulation respecting the disposal and treatment of waste water from isolated dwellings. To this end, municipalities are responsible for ruling on permit applications submitted under this bylaw.

A municipality cannot therefore issue a building permit if the planned wastewater treatment device does not comply with the regulations.

The municipality remains the privileged intermediary of the citizen. Like the collection of residual materials, it informs the owner of a septic tank of future collections.

What is the role of municipal building and environment inspectors?

Through municipal building and environment inspectors, municipalities, remain responsible for assessing the compliance of septic tanks on their territory and applying the bylaw concerning the emptying of septic tank sludge.

The inspector is mandated to inspect the land, the building and the septic installations. He may be accompanied by any person necessary for the performance of his work. An owner who refuses access to the land or the septic tank may be subject to an offense.

What is the role of Beauregard septic tanks?

Beauregard septic tanks is responsible for emptying septic tanks in the Township of Melbourne. Draining becomes a sort of third way of collecting residual materials, after recyclable materials and waste. Its mandate is to coordinate the schedule for emptying septic tanks and to follow up with the municipality to inform them of the schedule for emptying.
