SARBAGE BINS

YOU DON'T HAVE A WHEELED GARBAGE BIN? Read this

Please note that <u>as of January 1st, 2023</u>, the wheeled bin for the collection of household waste will be mandatory to comply with the mechanized truck system. The type of bin that will be accepted by the contractor is as shown below, the European model in either black or green color and with a capacity of 240 or 360 liters.

OR GREEN

This new procedure will not apply to the big garbage collection day.

Garbage that is left in:

- a wooden, metal or any other type of boxes;
- in a round trash can;
- > bags placed directly on the ground;
- or that does not correspond to the suggested models:

OVERFLOWS?

It is important to recognize the signs of a septic tank backflow. In order to be able to act quickly, here are some indicative signs of a septic tank problem:

- Water from toilets, drains and sinks that backs up into the house;
- Water from the bathtub, shower or sinks that takes time to drain;
- Gurgling noises in the pipes;
- Standing water near the septic tank or drain field;
- The presence of bad smell;
- Melting snow or heavy rain can also become a problem if the ground is saturated with water.

It is urgent to use the services of a professional to inspect, empty and unblock the pipes of the installation or to carry out excavation work on the ground, if necessary.

If your tank has been well designed, well located and well installed, emptying it on a regular basis can allow you to prolong the life of your septic system.

Never clean or empty your septic tank by yourself.





We would like to remind heavy vehicle users, farmers and transportation companies that the authorized

load limits are reduced during the thaw period on all public roads. This is done every year to take into account the lower carrying capacity of the road network during this period.

NEW IN ELBOURNE

To follow up on the text published in the last bulletin concerning styrofoam, the council of Melbourne has decided to install a bin that can collect expanded polystyrene.

Commonly called styrofoam, it is recyclable, but it is not accepted in the blue bin selective collection and therefore ends up in the landfill increasing the expenses for all the citizens. This material is already accepted at the Ecocentre, which sends it to Soprema, in Sherbrooke, to be integrated into the manufacture of insulating panels. The MRC's expanded polystyrene recovery pilot project aims to facilitate the recovery



of this material by citizens by installing municipal drop-off points. Clean containers can be placed in the box that will be installed near the municipal garage in early May.
