Eliminate styrofoam number 6

In an effort to reduce the garbage sent to our landfills, the Township of Melbourne invites its citizens to reduce the ecological impact by bringing styrofoam eligible, for recycling to the Ecocenter located on Keenan Road.

This type of styrofoam is found in electronic device packaging or even take out food sold in polystyrene containers.

When renting our community center, we will be strongly suggesting to replace the styrofoam food containers such as coffee cup, plates, etc, by more ecological alternatives.



Tax Credit for the Upgrading of Residential Waste Water Treatment Systems

You can claim this refundable tax credit for the 2017 to 2022 taxation years if you or your spouse paid qualified expenditures for the upgrading of a system for the discharge, collection and disposal of waste water from your principal place of residence or your cottage under a signed contract with a qualified contractor after March 31st, 2017, and before April 1st, 2022. Expired permit - Application for permit - What you should do?

Your permit has expired or is about to expire and there is still some work to be done? You must contact the inspector as soon as possible. Renovations or construction work performed without a valid permit is not permitted.

The firm Gestim has the mandate to study files, to issue new permits and also to answer questions concerning urban planning regulations. It is important to send your requests by email since this mode of communication will be prioritized.

Allow up to 30 days for issuance of a permit. Print the permit application form available on our website and return it by email at: inspecteur@melbournecanton.ca.

How to pay your municipal taxes

It is possible to pay your taxes directly at the townhall from Monday to Friday from 9 a.m. to noon and 1 p.m. and 4 p.m. Only payment in cash or by cheque is accepted. We do not have debit or credit payment.

It is also possible to pay through your financial institution. The reference to be entered is the customer number appearing on the payment slips. Add "0"s to get a sequence of four digits. (e.g. 0001).
