#### STYROFOAM BINS or CONTAINERS

As announced in our last bulletin, the new Styrofoam bin is now installed in the Town Hall parking lot, near the municipal garage.

You can bring all the styrofoam you have at home, instead of sending it to the landfill. In collaboration with the Ecocenter and Soprema, the material that will be collected will be recycled and integrated into the manufacture of insulating panels.

A nice gesture for the environment!

Temporary car shelters and garages must be completely removed from your property. The deadline for removing these shelters was April 15<sup>th</sup>. Owners found at fault will be notified, and a fine may be applied if the request is not respected.

# DATES TO REMEMBER

### **BIG GARBAGE DAY**

Be sure to set out your large items before 7:00 a.m. the morning of collection.

To ensure that everything will be picked up, please consult the list of items that will not be collected on that day. THEY WILL NOT PICK UP ANY:

- TYPE OF BUILDING MATERIALS; (sink, bath, windows, gypse etc.);
- ✓ TOXIC AND DANGEROUS PRODUCTS (solvents, paint, car batteries, spray cans etc.);
- ✓ AUTOMOBILES, BICYCLES, BOATS PARTS etc;
- ✓ HEAVY OBJECTS: Bags, boxes or containers that are too heavy to be lifted;
- ✓ **STACKED OBJECTS**: in a messy way, in a trailer or on a platform.

Items that can be disposed at the Eco-Center should be brought to 666 Keenan Road.
