



How to identify them?

A dangerous product is characterized by the following properties:

- Corrosive: product that destroys, corrodes and burns materials as well as the skin. (e.g. car battery).
- Flammable: product that ignites easily and burns briskly. (eg lighter fluid and turpentine).
- Toxic: product that acts as a poison on living beings (eg pesticides).
- Explosive: product that causes an explosion or the release of harmful vapors (eg compressed gas cylinder and aerosol).

Many household products have these characteristics. They are found stored in the kitchen, bathroom, workshop or garage of all Quebec homes. It is therefore necessary to know how to recognize them and eliminate them in a safe and effective manner.

Hazardous household waste accepted

The following hazardous products can be dropped off at the Ecocenter. It should be noted that only domestic quantities will be accepted.

Home products

- Ammonia (glass cleaner), household cleaner and oven cleaner
- Aerosol can
- Floor wax and stripper
- Fondue fuel
- Drain clog dissolver
- Stain remover
- Lotion and perfume
- Household battery
- Furniture and metal polish
- Nail polish and remover
- Old electronic products

Garden products

- Chemical fertilizer
- Weed killer
- Fungicide and herbicide
- Pesticide and insecticide
- Rat poison

Workshop products

- Antifreeze
- Waste oil
- Car battery
- Kerosene
- Glues
- Car wax and polish
- Brush cleaner
- Varnish, alkyd and latex paint
- Paint remover and stripper
- Gaz

Other types of products

- Acid for the swimming pool
- Propane tank
- Mothballs
- Mosquito repellent
- Shoe polish
- Photo finish chemical
