RECYCLING YOUR CHRISTMAS TREES

Come and drop off your Christmas tree to be recycled, shredded and transformed into mulch, compost and, in some cases, essential oils.

A drop-off point will be set up near the municipal garage. Be sure to bring them in before January 13th, 2025, stripped of all decorations, balls, icicles, hooks, etc.



Don't put them on the side of the road, as they won't be collected.

GARBAGE AND RECYCLING BINS – WHERE – WHEN – HOW?

To make sure that your bins are emptied, please follow these instructions:

- Place your wheeled bin <u>at the edge</u> of the public road, the day before the collection day, or before 7 a.m. of the scheduled morning.
- Wheels and handles must face the house, otherwise the bin will not be emptied.
- * Never place materials on the lid of the bin.
- Leave a distance of 1 m (3 ft.) between any other obstacle (tree, fence, car, etc.).
- Bags, boxes or any items placed on the ground will not be collected.
- To facilitate snow removal, please keep your bins off the public road.

If you notice the next day that your bin has been forgotten, please contact us as soon as possible.
