<u>BE CAREFUL ON GRAVEL ROADS</u>

Conditions have changed a lot in recent weeks: spring has arrived and the snow has almost disappeared. This is an important time of year, when much of the water stored in the snow is returned to the ground.

Freezing temperatures, snow, ice, rain... In spring, rising temperatures bring the risk of flooding and damage due to the accumulation of water created by melting snow.

Alternating thawing and freezing leads to deterioration of gravel roads. Work is possible, but the grader can only intervene effectively when the ground is no longer frozen. It is wiser and less costly to

wait until the end of the thaw period before undertaking work requiring the transport of heavy vehicles.

Our road supervisor constantly monitors all the roads to ensure the safety of users, school transport and emergency services. If you notice any major problems, please let us know.

We need your patience and caution every spring.

<u>2025 THAW PERIOD</u>

We wish to remind all heavy vehicle users, transporters as well as farmers that authorized load limits are reduced on our municipal roads during the thaw period. This is done every year to take into account the lower load-bearing capacity of the road network during this period.

For the 2025 thaw period, the target dates of the load restriction period for **Zone 1** are Monday, March 24th (12:01 a.m.) to Friday, May 23rd (11:59 p.m.). Dates are subject to change. Please check the Ministère des transports website by typing <u>ministère des transports dégel 2025 zone 1</u> in the search bar.



<u>2025 EMPTYING OF SEPTIC TANKS</u>

It's important to empty your septic tank at least every two years, which is not a luxury but a provincial legal obligation. The Act respecting wastewater disposal systems for isolated dwellings (Q-2, r.22) requires that your septic tank be emptied every 2 years to prevent breakage and the risk of overflow. By complying with this regulation, you protect your septic system and the environment.

Winter carports, also known as "Tempo" carports, must be removed by April 15th, at the latest. After this date, it is an offence punishable by fine. Simply moving them out of sight is not enough. You have to dismantle the whole thing (liner and structure).

<u>A REMINDER ABOUT SWIMMING POOL INSTALLATIONS</u>

Owners of swimming pools installed before November 1, 2010 have until September 30, 2025 to bring their installations up to standard. In the spring, a municipal inspector will visit all pools in the township.

Swimming pool safety rules apply to all types of installations, whether above-ground, in-ground or even demountable, and municipalities have a duty to enforce them.
